40 - PLUMBING; PROPER BACKFLOW DEVICES
Corrective Action: Protect the potable water supply with a backflow protection device, as required by applicable plumbing codes. All plumbing, plumbing fixtures, and grease interceptors shall be installed in compliance with local plumbing ordinances, shall be maintained so as to prevent any contamination, and shall be kept clean, fully operative, and in good repair. Any hose used for conveying potable water shall be of approved materials, labeled, properly stored, and used for no other purpose.
Observation: Observed submerged drain pipes from the beverage overflow troughs at the coffee station in the room behind the cooks' line. Elevate all drain pipes at least 1" above the rim of the floor sink.
California Retail Food Code: 114171, 114189.1, 114190, 114192, 114193, 114193.1, 114199, 114201, 114269

- NOTES
Observation: Reinspection found the following violations corrected:
--Handwash sinks on the cooks' line have towels
--Garlic in oil is no longer held out at room temperature
--Hard boiled eggs and blue cheese were no longer held on the ice bed
--The facility no longer vacuum packs
--The handwash sink in the Westin Club server station had warm water of 100F
--The sewage leak at left compartment of the Pantry three-compartment sink is repaired
--The split wooden serving plank has been removed
--Shelves are no longer covered in foil

The following violation remains uncorrected and will be checked at the next routine inspection:
--The drain pipe from the coffee overflow trough is still submerged
