23 - NO INSECTS, RODENTS, BIRDS OR NONSERVICE ANIMALS
Corrective Action: Eliminate the infestation/activity of cockroaches/rodents/flies/vermin from the food facility by using only approved methods. Remove all evidence of the infestation and thoroughly clean and sanitize all affected surfaces. Construct, equip, maintain and operate the food facility so as to prevent the entrance and harborage of animals, birds and vermin including, but not limited to, rodents and insects.
Observation: Observed 1 live, adult German cockroach in a crack at the upper right ceiling corner above the two-compartment sink by the dishwasher. Later, another cockroach was observed crawling down the wall by the dishwash area.

Observed mouse droppings in several locations: on the floor in the back kitchen at the north and east walls where the prep tables are, on the floor in the hallway where some wine boxes and white chef's shirts are located, on the floor in the "flour nook" where the large bulk bins of flour are located, on the floor along the walls in the upstairs dry storage room, and in various locations along the walls downstairs. The operator stated they have pest control between 2-3 times per month. Clean the mouse droppings, sanitize the affected areas, and continue regular pest control at the site.

- NOTES

Observation: Reinspection found all violations corrected except for the rodent droppings in various locations. This will be checked at the next routine inspection.

The cockroaches are gone and the dishwasher is providing over 50 ppm of chlorine during the sanitize cycle.

The permit is reinstated and the facility is cleared to reopen. The red closure placard has been removed and replaced with a green pass placard.
